

After completion, this icon will be on your desktop






Double click it to start ContentSmart

Default settings:


- **Video**: play full length

 If "slide interval" is not set in PowerPoint then play slide for 7 seconds.








Create your schedule or drag a preset template on the left to the right-box.

Create Your Own Weekly Schedule




Click & drag on the calendar or click **Add** button to create time slot.

Switch to Export Mode




Click **Export** on top or bottom to switch to Export mode.

Using PowerPoint with ContentSmart

- Add information to your images
 - Adding information to your image by using words, tables and other elements – even in portrait mode!
- Transparent table + background image
 - Creating beautiful & easy-to-modify menu or ads with transparent table and background image.
- Animations create simple and attractive movie
 - PowerPoint 2010 can save animated slides in video format.









Add Information to Your Images



- Change page setup to 16:9
 - Design -> Page Setup -> Slides sized for: -> On-screen Show (16:9)
- Place your images
- Add tables to area you want to add information



Transparent Table + Background Image



- Change page setup to 16:9
 - Design -> Page Setup -> Slides sized for: -> On-screen Show (16:9)
- Change background to image
 - Right click on empty space of slide -> Format Background -> Picture or texture fill -> choose your file and check "Tile picture as texture"
- Add tables to area you want to add information




Animations - Create Simple and Attractive Movie



- Change page setup to 16:9
 - Design -> Page Setup -> Slides sized for: -> On-screen Show (16:9)
- Overlay a table on top of image
 - Change table color and set transparent level to 30%
- Using Animations Pane to script your animation
 - Adding fade-in for images or fade-out to new images
- Save as .WMV
 - Planar MP-3450 can natively play video in WMV format



Multi-zone in Looping Schedule




Click on the circle button to expend layout details.

There are many layout templates available to choose from.




Create Looping Playlist for Each Zone



- Click on one of the zones to highlight it in yellow, corresponding playlist for that zone will be shown below.
- You can also select a zone by clicking on the thumbnail.
- Collapse the layout detail if you need more space for playlist.



Create Text Ticker





Multi-zone in Weekly Schedule



Each time slot can be assigned to a different layout format.

Note there may be a few second blink of black screen if two adjacent time slots are using different layout format.




Layout Aspect Ratio



- Depends on your screen's aspect ratio, you can set different aspect ratio for your player.
- It is recommended to use the same aspect ratio as your screen.




Vertical Aspect Ratio (Portrait Mode)



In Aspect ratio, select clockwise or counter-clockwise layout to schedule media in portrait mode.



Auto Rotate in Portrait Mode





Choose aspect ratio, schedule file, then export.














 - > Easy to assemble












Schedule GPIO



After the end of each GPIO


Select GPIO template

On digital signboards (XDS-104/151), after triggering a GPIO playlist, other GPIO trigger cannot interrupt playback.

On Full-HD players and signboards, another GPIO trigger can interrupt current playback and starts new playlist immediately.



Smart Widgets



Select one of the Smart Widget templates.



The **Widget** button is a shortcut to quickly bring user to widget layouts.



7 Smart Widgets Templates















7 SmartWidgets layouts:

- 1 x Full screen (1920x1080)
- 4 x layouts with 16:9 main region (1600x960) for wide screen video
- 2 x layouts with 4:3 main region (1296x972) for standard video or AV-input
- Note: Ticker Zone in SmartWidgets layouts only supports Caption mode when a text file is used




Smart Widgets Options



- Change background color for widgets.
- Select different city, enter city name or post/zip code and display temperature in Celsius or Fahrenheit.
- Enter username for Twitter feed.
- Enter URL for RSS or Webpage.




Clock & Calendar Widgets



- Under Options, user can modify each Widget's display duration.
- These 2 widgets use player's internal clock to display Clock & Calendar.
- If the time or date is wrong, plug in USB keyboard or connect player to the Internet for time synchronization online.


